- Waterproof stuff sacks or a few plastic bags
- Gear tape and or patches
- Sleeping bag liner
- Small camp pillow
- Toiletries- toothbrush, floss, deodorant, comb, nail clippers, moisturizer travel size soap, etc.
- Small hand sanitizer and travel size biodegradable soap for the worksite
