Program Overview:

We are currently looking to fill an immediate need for a GIS Intern to work in an office setting, in Estes Park, Colorado during the 2023-2024 winter-spring season. This position will support the Rocky Mountain National Park Trails Program and Facility Management division. This position focuses on improving the current GIS data for both the Trails Program and Facility Management to assist in project planning, compliance, and condition assessments. The reporting office location is at the Trails Office in Estes Park.

The GIS Intern will work with park Trails Program leadership to improve the current GIS data for the program. The position may also assist other work groups in the park Facility Management division to improve their GIS data in the park GIS database. Other work groups may include the Roads program, Professional Services work group, Buildings and Utilities work group and Asset Management work group.

The intern will also be provided opportunities to assist Trails personnel in operational tasks such as clearing snow from park walkways, clearing trees from park trails and assisting in building trail bridges.

General Qualifications:

This position should have strong familiarity with GIS database systems and software, including FieldMaps, ArcGIS and ArcCollector. This position should have the ability to perform their work both in an office setting and in field conditions. Experience with working with information and data related to trails and facility management infrastructure is important.

Physically challenging work requires exposure to cold, wind and loud noises around working equipment. This will have labor-intensive duties and requires the ability to hike long distances on

uneven terrain and lift/carry loads in excess of 40+ pounds. Boots and weather attire should be worn or brought to the field every day and will not be provided.

Applicants are expected to have good communication skills and follow all government safety protocols.

Requirements:

- High School Diploma or equivalent
- 18 Years of age or older with a valid driver license and clean driving record.
- Eligibility to work in the US
- This position is supported by the Public Lands Hiring Authority which requires candidates to be between the ages of 16 to 30.
- Pre-service background screening required, including FBI background check
- Must be able to provide proof of eligibility to work in the United States

This position is classified as Temporary Non-Exempt and is a seasonal position with no benefits.
