



## ROCKY MOUNTAIN YOUTH CORPS 2024 Wildland Fire and Fuels Intern

<b>Plus:</b>	Housing allowance up to \$150/week Boot allowance up to \$400 Public Land Corps Hiring Authority upon completion of 640 hours on public lands. Paid sick leave

### **Program Overview:**

This position will be working as a member of a fuels reduction crew hosted and supervised by the Little Snake Field Office. Primary duties will include operating a chainsaw, stacking cut material into piles, spraying weeds, hiking over uneven terrain, and camping overnight. Crew members will be trained in the use of chainsaws and wildland firefighting, previous experience is preferred but not required. The successful applicant must have a strong work ethic, positive attitude, and a willingness to learn. The Bureau of Land Management will provide all supplies and equipment needed to perform the job. Participants will need to purchase minimum 8" high, lace-type exterior leather work boots with lug melt-resistant soles. \$400 boot reimbursement is provided by RMYC.

Throughout the season there will be opportunities to work on prescribed burns and wildland fire assignments. While on fire assignments the incumbent will switch from RMYC's payroll to being paid directly by the agency in charge of the fire (AD status).

### **General Qualifications:**

- Applicants must be able to perform arduous labor in remote locations for 10-12 hours per day.
- Ability to pass Arduous Duty Pack Test (3-mile walk on flat ground with 45-pound pack in 46 minutes). This is required for the opportunity to work on wildland fires.
- Experience with strenuous physical activity such as participating in sports or having an active lifestyle.
- Willingness to travel.

**Requirements:**

- High School Diploma or equivalent
- 18 Years of age or older with a valid driver license and clean driving record.
- This position is supported by the Public Lands Hiring Authority which requires candidates to be between the ages of 16 to 30.
- Pre-service background screening required, including FBI background check
- Must be a US Citizen, National, or Lawful Permanent Resident. Documentation will be required on the first day.

*This position is classified as Temporary Non-Exempt and is a seasonal position with no benefits.*
